



SEASON 15

Shaking Pelves and Hattifnatter's Parade shocked everyone by hoisting the championship trophies at the end of Season 14. What surprises are in store for us this season? If last season's playoffs are any indication, the final season of Era 5 should be epic!

ALTDORF CONFERENCE

NORTH

Orkemon enter the season with a ridiculous 2600 TV. They may be unstoppable unless someone can prune that powerhouse roster. The Doom That Came to The OFL is built to prune rosters, with 2 CPOMBERs and 3 Dirty Players. Thul Boss 3 v0 returns to lead the offense despite his pitiful playoff performance. Flipping Fools come into the season with quite a few rookies. If even a few of them can survive long enough to provide quality depth, they'll be in the race until the end. Nebraskull Hornhuskers is a team.

Players to watch: Navani (Orkemon) the clawed lineman; Everyone from The Doom – they're all mean; Doink (Fools) needs to have a big season; Ki'Zik (Huskers) the former Brukestadt Stalkers standout may make everyone forget about Big, and Lil Red.

Prediction: Orkemon. Never pick against Darken in the regular season.

WEST

Snap, Crackle, and Pop! is a very balanced squad. Their only potential weakness is the lack of a bench if they

get involved in a war of attrition. Da Pumpkin Patch have a pair of 5 ST Black Orcs to anchor their line. They are still searching for a replacement for the legendary Trik. Back For More is the dark horse team here. Expect them to bounce back after a disappointing Season 14. The team is built around a pair of FA Wights. Pdarby dumped Chaos Dwarfs for a new Underworld team. Shinra Corp should be fun to watch with all of the inducements they'll be receiving.

Players to watch: Sulal (SCP), Git of Treet (DPP) are likely to take over as the main killers or their teams; Prayer (BFM) Just a hunch here, but he could develop into something special; Fester (Shinra) will be the team's main blitzer.

Prediction: Snap, Crackle, and Pop! should take it, but don't sleep on Belasco's Undead.

EAST

Hattifnatter's Parade are hoping to bring another trophy back to Moominvalley. They'll be trying to be the first team to repeat since The Dark Spades in Seasons 2-3. Frozen Tallywackers got off to a great start last season, but couldn't keep it up. Rumors have been swirling about the

return of Beef Whistle. Hollywood Undead dropped 4 of their first 5 matches last season, and never managed to climb out of that hole. They'll be back with a vengeance this season, led by rising star Taylor Lautner. Contagious has the potential to be one of the hardest hitting teams in the league. It is probably time to part ways with Yellow Fever.

Players to watch: Snusmumriken (Parade) he loves balls; Unr Kegsplitter (Tallywackers) Cocked locked and ready to rock; Taylor Lautner (Hollywood) he hates shirts; Mad Cow (Contagious) he'll be the only guy on the team who isn't punching people in the face.

Prediction: Hollywood Undead return to form and edge out Hattifnatter's Parade.

SOUTH

Hexoatl Hurricanes have an open free agent slot. It may be necessary to add a Loqteu-hi or Conqa of Axlotl if they want to make a playoff run. Blizzard can be a scoring machine despite his injuries. No one can explain what happened to the Cereal Killers last season. Consider it a fluke, and expect them to return to dominant form this season. Dazed and Confused will

show no quarter as they show their new division-mates a whole lotta love (and boots). After a dreadful second season, Sunhawk has decided to drop The Walking Dead. Too bad AMC wasn't this smart. He'll be bringing back his NYC Infestation for a season of wizards and Glart Smashrip.

Players to watch: MSG (Killers) because Slam loves minotaurs; Bron Y Aur Stomp (D&C) Breast of gold, boots of steel; The Hurricanes' and Infestation's most exciting players are probably sitting in the free agent pool right now. Watch for The Hurricanes to hire a killer Saurus, and The Infestation to hire a game-changing Gutter Runner.

Prediction: Cereal Killers – They're G-r-reat!

CENTRAL

The Phoenix Kings are not happy about the way last season's playoffs ended for them. You can bet Connor MacCrimmon will have the boys focused and playing at top form as they make another run at the championship. Battlehammer BBC needs to pretend every team is The Phoenix Kings. Voltron is 4-0-0 against his former team this Era.

Inconsistency against everyone else has cost them playoff berths. Calamitous Intent will have to step up their game if they want to continue to be recognized as the leader in organized havoc. Fi\$T Fir\$t are looking to rebound from a disastrous season. Manni has a chance to the league's career leader in both Receptions and Touchdowns.

Players to watch: Connor MacCrimmon (Kings) C-Mac is a beast; Unkk Thunderfoot (Battlehammer) 5 AG Runner; Baron Underbheit (Calamitous Intent); Manni (Fi\$T Fir\$t) will go down (for \$10) as one of the best Catchers in league history.

Prediction: This could be C-Mac's final season. The Kings want to send him out on a high note.

WAAAGH CONFERENCE

Our Season 14 Waaagh picks were craptastic. Only 2 correct division winners. 2 of our wildcard picks made the playoffs (Khorne's Karnage won their division). Flash Gitz were the first defending champs to miss the playoffs since Mortikal's Raiders in Season 2. Electric Mayhem was our pick to come out of The WFC. That ended well.

NORTH

Lizardpool BBC has made it to the conference championship game in two straight seasons. Despite losing Renaldo, their Skinks are still crazy good. They still have an open FA spot if they decide that's what they need to put them over the top. UFC Football has had a hard time keeping players alive, and their best players are banged up. It might be a long season for them. The Creeps will be finishing up their clinic on 'How to Completely Waste a 4 ST Werewolf' this season. The Volkn Pyros are Wildfire's new Skaven team. Rumor has it, they are trying to lure Ming the Merciless back into the game. Are you Volkn kidding me?

Players to watch: Jawjammin (Lizardpool) may be the top Saurus in the league; Zugg (UFC) is the best hitter on the team; White Fang (Creeps) is hoping he can survive the season, and play for a real team in Era 6; Notta Hamster (Pyros) the 6 ST Rat Ogre will team up with Headsplitter to give opponents fits.

Prediction: Lizardpool should run away with the division title. The big test will come in the playoffs, where anything short of a trip to the finals will be viewed as a disappointment.

WEST

Expectations are high for The Wasch Eng Tomb Generals after winning The West in their first season. Electric Mayhem is built around a strong core of Mummies and Wights. They need to develop a solid ball carrier. Beautiful DayMonster looks like he'll be the ball carrier, at least temporarily. The Karak Kadrin Slayers are loaded with Guard and Mighty Blow, like every other Dwarf team. Unlike other Dwarf teams, they have the pieces to strike quick on offense. Lawquoter is bringing a new High Elf team, Tironic Rams. They kinda have to be better than The Hood Rats, right?

Players to watch: Harvey Harv Babetch (Generals) A skeleton with Claws; Ben the Virgin (Mayhem) may be the best Zombie ever - You'd think he could get laid; Joe Monaynya (Slayers) an 8 MV Dwarf is just fucking wrong; Charlaiel Howley (Rams) 4 ST Blitzer.

Prediction: This could go a lot of ways. We're gonna go with an upset here and take The Slayers.

EAST

Khorne's Karnage was undefeated before falling in the first round of the playoffs. Were they overconfident? Was it Nuffle flexing his muscles and putting them in their place? Or is Squall just awesome? They will, once again, be one of the favorites to win it all. The Maelstrom Marauders came up just short of the playoffs last season, in what is starting to become a trend for Hammertime. With their nicely balanced roster, they should make it in this season. Four of Jurassic Park Diners' Saurus have Dodge. They

need to bash more effectively if they want to make the post season. Scum and Villainy enter Season 15 with Confidence and Momentum. Unfortunately, Confidence and Momentum are not the names of twin, fire-breathing, invisible Skaven who possess a new skill called Touch of Death, and score touchdowns two at a time. It's going to be another long season for these guys.

Players to watch: Fabeto III (Karnage) is coming after Amoxos; Omegon (Marauders) averages 25.5 Casualties per season this Era; I Ate Samuel Jackson (Diners) will score a lot; **Prediction:** Khorne's Karnage crushes the competition.

SOUTH

Tragic Failures: Still bullshit. Team Fantastic damn near won the title in their first season. To celebrate, the league has decided to institute 'Bring a Rock to The Game Day' for all Team Fantastic matches. Fans are allowed to bring a rock weighing up to 46 lbs to the game, and any fan who hits a member of Team Fantastic with a rock wins a cash prize! Creeping Death's roster is loaded. They should make some noise this season, competing for the Golden Scimitar and a playoff spot. Dead Man's Hand has developed nicely after one season of play, but it's going to be difficult for them to stay in contention in this brutal division.

Players to watch: Morgan Twerp (Failures) hopefully he dies this season; Kaigan (TF) Kill all the mens! Xezbeth (Death) will have a breakout season; Mad Moxxi (DMH) SWF looking 4 STR.

Prediction: Tragic Failures succeed again. So. Much. Bullshit.

UP

The Fjord Mustangs won the division last season and sent four players to the Pro Bowl. Scorn and Fuzbol will

have them in contention again. Heading into the new season with a pair of rookie Flesh Golems is not ideal, but don't count Cactuar Resurrection out. Squall plays well as the underdog, and will have Wilhelm Chaney at his disposal in many games. What in the hell happened to The Flash Gitz last season? They became the first defending champs to miss the playoffs since Mortikal's Raiders in Season 2. The team is too strong to miss out twice in a row. After a promising start, The Dagger Devils failed to win a game after week 6 last season.

Players to watch: Scorn the Howler (Mustangs) is always a nightmare for the opposition; Brimstone Reborn (Resurrection) 20+ Casualties - guaranteed; Madhattan Mauler (Gitz) a 5 AG Orc ranks just lower than a 5 AG Vampire on the Bullshit Scale; Kamikaze Korg (Devils) should live up to his name.

Prediction: Flash Gitz

LOTHERN CONFERENCE

NORTH

Rise of The Depesticons were LFC runners up last season. They have one of the top defenses in the league, anchored by Antibiotic Resistant. The Silverion Sabres set a record by missing the playoffs with 11 points – that would have been enough to win 6 divisions! Gravio Fleet has one foot in the grave, which leaves Selwyn Westwells to carry the team. Real Sociopaths performed well, especially for a new Chaos team entering in the second season of an Era. Balthazar will have to ramp up the violence for

them to take the next step. Cockney Rhyming Slann were one of our sleeper teams entering last season, but then they went out and laid an egg. Then someone stepped on that egg; and someone else took a dump on that egg; and then someone – well, you get the point. It was a rough season. They could end up being the most improved team with just a little love from Nuffle.

Players to watch: Vortex (Depesticons); Selwyn Westwells (Sabres); Anton Chigurh (Sociopaths) Hope nothing bad happens to him in week 1; Sweeney Todd (CRS) baddest Daredevil around.

Prediction: The Depesticons. They are built to win it all.

WEST

The last two LFC champions reside in The West. Shaking Pelves The World Title last season. Their amazing troupe of Catchers will take them far again. Funk All Stars came out of nowhere to take The LFC by storm last season. They have the best pair of Werewolves in the league. Darkland Raiders missed the playoffs after winning the World Championship in Season 13. They should bounce back strong. Last season, Action Pact was more disappointing than Terminator Salvation. They promise to return with more explosions than a Michael Bay wet dream. Wait, they get to blow shit up?

Players to watch: Tina 1Turner (Pelves) is simply the best; James Wolfenson (All Stars) he's a superfreak; Aelaeith (Raiders) +ST Frenzy lineman; Patrick Swayze (Action Pact) What do you mean he isn't on the team? Seriously? Road House? Point Break? Steel Dawn? RED fucking Dawn? Wolveriiiiiiiiines!!!

Prediction: Funk All Stars squeak by on tiebreakers in a dead heat with The Pelves and Raiders.

EAST

Halfpint Heroines are one of the top fouling teams in the league. They killed 12 opponents last season! This could be the perfect division for The Stampa Face Buccaneers. They should have a lot of fun smashing Skinks and Halflings and Amazons. Bringing a new Lizardman team into the third season of an Era is tough, so expect Nuffle to be a little hard on Reptile Dysfunction. They're probably just looking to develop some talent for next season. Sugar n Spice were probably hoping to avoid the division with Dwarfs, but things could be worse. They might be able to make a run at the division title.

Players to watch: Julia Budd (Heroines) made the Pro Bowl as a Runner; Grim Stok Jr. (Bucs) the team's main enforcer; Damballah the

Bondye (RD) Dirty Player Skink? Hell yeah! Fook Mi (S&S) is close to acquiring Piling On.

Prediction: Halfpint Heroines. Yep.

SOUTH

The positional players from Angry Birds are ridiculous. They are the odds on favorites to win The LFC. Ascent of The Autobeads had the #1 defense last season. No reason to think they can't repeat that feat. Confederacy of Dunces only scored 8 TDs last season. If they can develop an adequate offense, they can contend for a wildcard; No one really knows what to make of The Schlonglings, but they should be fun.

Players to watch: Tziporah (Birds) a true pain in the ass; Assistant Braidsmaid (Autobeads) is the only Hobgoblin on the team who is worth

a crap; George PewPew Bush (CoD) is a true genius; Thomas the Tank (Schlonglings) is the only one on the team who seems to have a clue what he's doing.

Prediction: Unless someone manages to trim their roster, Angry Birds should win it.

RECORDS & MILESTONES

CAREER WINS

Quite a few coaches can reach 50 wins this season. Norse is nearly a lock. He only needs 4 wins to hit 50. Pdarby is only 9 away, but it seems unlikely he'll get there with a new Underworld team. Matts (39 wins), Remthar (38 wins), Sabonnel (37 wins), 20Phoenix (36 wins), and Dreamy (35 wins) could get there this season.

Toast and Thul could both reach 100 wins, but it won't be easy. Toast needs 8 wins, Thul needs 12. Lazarus has won 11+ games eight times. If he can do it again, he'll reach 150 wins.

Darken needs 1 win to hit 150, so, unless he gets eaten by a tiger or something, congratulations Darken Rahl.

GAMES PLAYED

OPHare will reach 100. A good playoff run would get Norse to 150. He needs 19. Cullen and BSU will both get to 200. Slam, Astro Darken, and Wildfire will all hit 250 games played at some point this season. Thul will also reach 250 if he makes the playoffs.

CAREER CASUALTIES

Scorn the Howler (Fjord Mustangs) and Unr Kegsplitter (Frozen Tallywackers) could both reach 100 Career Casualties. Scorn needs 16. Unr needs 13 (If Unr gets 14, he passes Mulcana to become the most violent Big Guy).

Kaigan will pass Trik as the most violent player in league history if he can reach 29 Casualties this season.

CAREER RECEPTIONS

Manni (Fi\$T Fir\$t) needs only 2 Receptions to pass Solja Slim for the all-time lead.

CAREER TOUCHDOWNS

Amoxos holds the record with 65. Both Manni (58) and Morgan 'Bullshit' Twerp (55) have a shot at him.

CAREER RUSHING YARDS

Amoxos also hold the career rushing record with 3588 yards. Fabeto II (Karnage) is sitting at 2944 coming into this season. He needs 645 yards.

MOST BATTERED

If Connor MacCrimmon is injured 4 times, he'll pass Mulcana as the league's Most Battered player.
